Kindergarten Spotlight

Kindergarten is learning about how animals and humans depend on trees. The Blank Park Zoo brought animals that live in trees to share with our students.

In skills block, students are learning how to record and decode the beginning, middle and ending sounds in CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant) words. Students have started working independently at literacy centers focusing on reading and writing skills.

In math, students are continuing to learn how to count to 100, identify what comes before and after a number, add up to ten, and write numbers 1-30.
